Topic: Santa Pal Program –will give a better Christmas for about 150 Harker Heights families. This is about 600-700 individuals they will give a good meal and gifts for children up to age 17. The food costs are about \$3500 and toys & gifts run around \$6000. Families have 2 weeks to apply. Applications will be reviewed to determine the need and those approved will be notified. The Santa Pal program is accepting cash donations and unwrapped toys or gifts. 100% of what is received in donations will be given out to those in need. The application should be turned in to the HH Activity Center and the distribution will be done at Station #2 on Stillhouse Lake Rd this year. The HH Fire Dept will do the Santa run again this year. They will start at Harker Heights High School on Christmas Eve at 6 pm. At least 2 trucks will be out in the neighborhoods, possibly a third truck this year since the city has grown so much. Cash donations can be taken to City Hall and it will be deposited in the account.

Human Rights Day is celebrated annually across the world on 10 December every year.

The date was chosen to honour the United Nations General Assembly's adoption and proclamation, on 10 December 1948, of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR), the first global enunciation of human rights and one of the first major achievements of the new United Nations. The formal establishment of Human Rights Day occurred at the 317th Plenary Meeting of the General Assembly on 4 December 1950, when the General Assembly declared resolution 423(V), inviting all member states and any other interested organizations to celebrate the day as they saw fit.
