"Important Dates and Deadlines" for consideration are: January 31 – 1099-R First Wave of Mailing; February 15 – Second Wave of mailing 1099; March 1 – Third Wave of 1099 mailing; March 15 – Fourth Wave of 1099 mailing; April 17 – IRS Tax Filing or Extension Request Deadline ("Subject to move change in event that Emancipation Day is observed on Monday, April 16, the tax filing deadline will be moved to April 17"); October 15 – IRS Extension Tax Filing Date. * *SOURCE:* "Getting Ready for Year-End & The 2018 Tax Season" published by LPL Finance.
