In 2003, the Texas legislature eliminated funding for the supervising of Family Outreach social workers. As a result, all but ten Family Outreach Centers closed and the Central Texas region went from four centers to only one. **Mission:** To aid in the prevention of child abuse and family violence through education, case management, and referrals to high risk populations. **Vision:** We strive to be the premier prevention advocate for empowering survivors and creating a culture of care for those affected by child abuse and family violence. **Core Values:** Compassion: We understand the circumstances and viewpoints of others while promoting a peaceful, caring and safe community.
