Topic: Bell County C.R.I.M.E.S Intelligence Fusion Center – www.bellcountycrimes.org is an online platform for the community to feel comfortable in reporting information. All information will be analyzed on its merits and upon corroboration will be forwarded to the Bell County Sheriff’s Dept. It is a virtual Neighborhood Watch program. Law enforcement does not have the time to collect and analyze all the small bits of information that may be reported around the county. The CRIMES team puts all these pieces together to help solve the crimes. They want information regarding human trafficking, terrorism, criminal behavior or suspicious activity especially if it involves children and teens. “See something, say something”! They are not 911 so if there is an emergency do call 9-1-1. FYI : Pancake Day Education

Shrove Tuesday (also known in [Commonwealth](#) countries and [Ireland](#) as **Pancake Tuesday** or **Pancake Day**) is the day in February or March immediately preceding [Ash Wednesday](#) (the first day of [Lent](#)), which is celebrated in some countries by consuming [pancakes](#). In others, especially those where it is called [Mardi Gras](#) or some translation thereof, this is a [carnival](#) day, and also the last day of "fat eating" or "gorging" before the fasting period of Lent.

Ash Wednesday is a [Christian](#) holy day of [prayer](#) and [fasting](#). It is preceded by [Shrove Tuesday](#) and falls on the first day of [Lent](#), the six weeks of [penitence](#) before [Easter](#). Ash Wednesday is traditionally observed by [Western Christians](#). It is observed by [Anglicans](#), most [Latin Rite Roman Catholics](#), [Lutherans](#), [Methodists](#), [Moravians](#), [Nazarenes](#), [Independent Catholics](#), as well many from the [Reformed](#) faith.
