TAXES 2019

The Tax Cut and Jobs Act legislation was signed into law on December 22, 2017. The Act makes extensive changes that affect both individuals and businesses. It is not too early to start analyzing and calculating your tax liability for the tax year 2018. Here are two considerations about Itemized Deduction: 1) Medical expenses. In the Pre-existing law (2017), medical expenses were deductible but not to exceed 10% of the AGI floor ... in the tax year 2018, the 10% AGI floor is reduced to 7.5% for both 2017 and 2018. 2) Home mortgage interest. Previously, home mortgage was limited to \$1,000,000 for home equity loan, one-half those amounts for married filing separately. In the "New Year", the limit is \$750,000 for married filing separately and no home equity loan; the \$1,000,000/\$500,000 limit still applies to debt incurred before December 16, 2017.
