**Topic:** Human Trafficking – is the modern day slavery. There is twice as many today as the entire trans-Atlantic slave trade of the past. It is the buying and selling of human beings for labor, sex trade, child sex or labor and forced marriages. The worst area has been in the eastern US, or the I-35 and I -10 routes and cities such as LA, NYC and Houston. Most vulnerable are those in foster care system, runaways, homeless and youth with special needs. They look for victims at bus stops, malls, parties, school, internet and gang girlfriends. **Oktoberfest** (German pronunciation: [ɔk'to:bɐˌfɛst]) is the world's largest [Volksfest](#) ([beer festival](#) and [travelling funfair](#)). Held annually in [Munich, Bavaria, Germany](#), it is a 16- to 18-day [folk festival](#) running from mid or late September to the first weekend in October, with more than six million people from around the world attending the event every year. Locally, it is often called the *Wiesn*, after the colloquial name for the fairgrounds, Theresa's meadows ([Theresienwiese](#)). The Oktoberfest is an important part of [Bavarian](#) culture, having been held since the year 1810. Other cities across the world also hold [Oktoberfest celebrations](#) that are modeled after the original Munich event. Oktoberfest in Texas starts 14 September 2018.
