Oktoberfest (German pronunciation: [ɔk'to:bɐˌfɛst]) is the world's largest [Volksfest](#) ([beer festival](#) and [travelling funfair](#)). Held annually in [Munich](#), [Bavaria](#), [Germany](#), it is a 16- to 18-day [folk festival](#) running from mid or late September to the first weekend in October, with more than six million people from around the world attending the event every year. Locally, it is often called the *Wiesn*, after the colloquial name for the fairgrounds, Theresa's meadows ([Theresienwiese](#)). The Oktoberfest is an important part of [Bavarian](#) culture, having been held since the year 1810. Other cities across the world also hold [Oktoberfest celebrations](#) that are modeled after the original Munich event. Oktoberfest in Texas starts 14 September 2018.
